HELP WITH WINTER HEATING BILLS FOR THE OVER 60'S IN THE TOWN OF EVESHAM

If you are aged 60 and over residing in the civic parish of Evesham which includes the parishes of Great and Little Hampton, Bengeworth and Evesham, **but not other postal areas of the Evesham district**, John Martin's Charity will help with a grant towards winter heating bills provided:-

1. You live on your own and your total income from all sources does not exceed £220 per week*.
- OR -
2. You live with a spouse or partner and the total income from all sources does not exceed £280 per week*.
- AND -
3. Your savings/investments and/or capital (excluding own residence) does not exceed £12,000.

(* Attendance Allowance and Disabled Living Allowance are excluded from the income calculation. If you live with anyone, other than a spouse or partner, their income will be discounted.)

HOW TO APPLY

Please note that documents confirming the total income and savings of the individual or couple applying must be provided.

This includes evidence of current income, such as pension correspondence (state and private), bank and building society statements, pass books and details of all savings and investments.

There is no longer any automatic qualification for those in receipt of Pension Credit.
