Acceptable evidence includes utility bills (not Council Tax), Bank / Building Society/credit card statements, student loan and university fee letters, being dated 12 months ago and within 6 weeks of the application. (NB – 2 confirmations of address are required which must be in original hard copy format; Bank statements etc.. produced via the internet will not be accepted).
