FURTHER/HIGHER EDUCATION AWARDS ACADEMIC YEAR 2010 – 2011

Applications are invited for Grants from students aged 16 and over on 1 September 2010.

To qualify for a grant you must have been a permanent resident in the TOWN OF EVESHAM for a minimum period of 12 months immediately prior to the 1st September 2010.

All applicants aged 25 and over are subject to a financial assessment.

The categories are as follows:

CATEGORY A: Full or part time, HND, Degree level and Postgraduate courses at a University or College. Students attending educational establishments within a 25 mile radius of the Charity's offices will be classed as "Home" students. Age: 18 to state retirement age.

CATEGORY C: Part-time vocational or educational courses, other than degree level. Courses must be deemed as a part time course by the educational establishment, can be part of a modern apprenticeship/day release. Courses must run for 3 terms or equivalent (60 hours minimum over an academic year). Recreational courses are excluded. Age: 16 to state retirement age.

CATEGORY D: Vocational courses towards Degrees at the Open University. Age: 18 to state retirement age.

Applications are available from Thursday, 1st July 2010 by personal collection, via the Charity's Internet Site or by post (a stamped addressed envelope must be provided).
