## FURTHER/HIGHER EDUCATION GRANTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 – 2021

The Charity is pleased to invite Students to apply for an Education Grant.

To qualify for a grant, you must meet the required age as at 1 September 2020.

You must also have been a permanent resident or (if living away from home during term time) have maintained a residential address in the TOWN OF EVESHAM for a minimum period of 12 months immediately prior to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020.

All applicants aged 25 and over are subject to a financial assessment.

The categories are as follows:

**CATEGORY A:** Full or part time, HND, Degree level and Postgraduate courses at a University or College. Age: 18 to state retirement age.

**CATEGORY C:** Part-time vocational or educational courses, other than degree level. Courses must be classed as a part time course by the educational establishment and can be part of a modern apprenticeship/day release. Courses must run for 3 terms or equivalent (60 hours minimum over an academic year). Recreational courses are excluded. Age: 16 to state retirement age.

**CATEGORY D:** Vocational courses towards Degrees at the Open University or Degree level distance learning. Age: 18 to state retirement age.
